On Thursday, May 28, 2009 DCEC met with O'Connell Electric at the Delaware County Waste-to-Energy Project in Hamden, NY. O'Connell Electric was accompanied by a film crew, Oswego Creative, Inc. out of Arvada, Colorado. This crew was hired by the National Electrical Contractors Association (NECA). NECA is a national organization that serves the management interests of the entire electrical contracting industry. NECA has 123 chapters across the country and support the advocacy, education, research and standards development of the electrical contracting industry.

Kevin Villegas of Oswego Creative interviewed Greg Starheim, CEO/General Manager of DCEC, Paul DeAndrea, Manager of Engineering & Technology, as well as Tim Ehman of O'Connell Electric about the development of the Delaware County Waste-to-Energy Project.
