DCMO BOCES COMPLETES SOLAR/PV PROJECT

DELHI, NY, December 28, 2011:

Construction has been completed on a solar photovoltaic (PV) project rated at 12 kW at the DCMO BOCES Western Delaware campus located near Trout Creek, NY. The project was successfully interconnected with the DCEC system on November 10, 2011. This PV system consists of 50 PV panels and associated inverters and it is expected to produce approximately 13,500 kWh annually.

“This project will be a great learning tool for our students here on campus”, says Doreen Rowe, Assistant Superintendent for Management Services. “Students will be able to track the amount of energy the project is producing as well as its monthly monetary savings.”

Partial funding assistance for the construction of this project was provided by DCEC through an agreement with the New York Power Authority (NYPA). The BOCES project is the thirteenth and final project receiving funding assistance from DCEC under the agreement with NYPA.
