## **QUALIFICATIONS**:

In order to be considered students must meet the following qualifications:

- O Be in their junior (11<sup>th</sup> grade) year
- 0 Be a son/daughter of a member of the Delaware County Electric Cooperative
- O Have at least a "B" average or better
- O Participate in extra-curricular activities and community service

## APPLICATION PROCESS:

Students interested in being considered for this scholarship must complete the below application and have it <u>submitted to</u> <u>the office of the Delaware County Electric Cooperative by March 15, 2023</u>. Applications can either be sent by regular mail or emailed to: <u>Janelle.Linehan@dce.coop</u>.

A completed application must include:

- 1. Completed form below
- 2. 1-page student essay describing yourself (including where you go to school, favorite subjects, extra-curricular activities, and community service you have been involved in) and what you hope to get out of participating in the trip
- 3. Letter of recommendation from a teacher or administrator from your school, including your academic transcript showing an academic standing of at least a "B" average or above
- 4. Attach a copy of your family's DCEC electric bill proving their membership in the Cooperative
- 5. Be available to meet DCEC Board of Directors between 4:30 -5:30 pm on Tuesday, March 28, 2023 online or in-person
